City of Union Taxes Remain the Same

The tax rates for the City of Union Events have been set for the 2017-18 year.

The rates remain at \$2.16 per \$1000 of assessed valuation for real property and \$1.88 per \$1000 of assessed valuation on all tangible personal property. These rates are the same as 2016-17, and have remained at that same rate for more than five years.

“We are very proud that we are keeping taxes level here in the City of Union,” Mayor Larry Solomon said. “Through responsible and conservative fiscal management, we have been able to keep the city expenses in line with our revenues and still provide high-quality services to our residents.”

Tax bills for the city will be mailed in early October, and those bills paid before October 31, 2017, will receive a discount of two-percent. Taxes become delinquent on December 31, 2017.
