

Breakfast with Santa FAQ

When: December 10, 2016, from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Where: Union Fire Protection District (Union Fire House), 9611 US 42

What: Breakfast with Santa. The City will provide pastries/donuts, along with Hot Chocolate, Coffee and Juice. Santa will be available for photos, and to listen to gift requests from young and old.

Why: This is a service to the residents of Union. No, you do not have to be a resident to attend.

What Can I bring?: We are asking those who attend, if they would like, an item to help one of the two Northern Kentucky charities we've identified to help this holiday season. The first is the Boone County Animal Shelter. They are in need of cat litter, pet toys, dry and canned dog and cat food, paper towels, peanut butter and liquid laundry detergent. The second is Steinfeld Toy Foundation. They are in need of a new, unwrapped toy for children from 0-18. All donations to Steinfeld stay in Northern Kentucky.

What to Know: Parking is limited. You should plan on parking near the Harmony Subdivision, and you may have to walk to the Union Fire House for the event. We recommend to carpool if you can!

Bring your cameras. We will not have a photographer on hand to take a photo with Santa for you, but you may take as many photos as you can while your child is with Santa.

What will be there to do?: We will be providing a snack of donuts and beverages. We will have a couple of crafts available for the kids to do while they wait or after they visit Santa. The Union Fire Protection District will have (if no emergencies arise) several fire trucks to look at, and some fire personnel will be on hand to answer questions, provide important fire safety info, and give tours of the building. The Boone County Animal Shelter will be on hand with a few adoptable animals for children to see, and will also be on hand to answer questions about pet care and their shelter. We also have a few surprises still in the planning stages as well.
