US Highway 42 To Close On June 29 for Parade

Area residents will be affected by the closure of US Highway 42 on Friday, June 29, from approximately 7 p.m. to 7:45 p.m.

The area between Braxton Road and Mt. Zion Road will be closed starting at 7 p.m. for the annual Union Celebrates America Parade. US42 will reopen immediately following the conclusion of the parade event.

The area of OldUS42/Old Union Road between Mt. Zion Road and new US42 will also be closed from 6 p.m. until 11 p.m. for through traffic. The city will hold a street party in that area, featuring live music from the Wulfe Brothers Band, beer from Braxton Brewery and food truck vendors from the Cincinnati Food Trucks Association and children's activities including bounce houses, balloon art, crafts and a bubble machine. The event will conclude at approximately 10 p.m. with a fireworks show by Vito's Fireworks.

This is the ninth year for the Celebrate America Event, and the event continues to grow. The Celebrate America event is free to attend, and you are not required to be a resident of the city.
